Fall is now upon us and leaves will be changing. We will get to see first hand what God's paint brush can do.







Some of these are referenced in the bible in Col 2:16, Eph 3:10 & 6:12.

In Tobit 12:15, there is a reference to the existence of seven Archangels: "I am Raphael, one of the seven holy angels present the prayers of the saints and enter into the presence of the glory of the holy one." But only two other Archangels are mentioned by name; Michael and Gabriel. Notice that all three of these names end with "EL" which is a Hebrew reference for "God."

Guardian Angels occupy the lowest spot on the choir. Each of us as a guardian angel assigned to them whose role it is to watch out after us and ensure that we make it into heaven. Did you know that you could pray to someone else's guardian angel to help that other person in time of need or trouble? So, the next time you see a friend that is heading for trouble, pray to their guardian angel to come to their assistance.


